

Marston Has E-books!

It's like an online library!

Thanks to the PTA and our successful book fair, Marston was able to purchase e-books! E-books can be **downloaded** onto a device so that it is portable (such as an iPad, Itouch, Iphone, or tablet) or **read online**(need internet--on a computer, laptop, nook, kindle or the previously mentioned devices). It is just like an online library--all free. It works like a book being read on a Nook or Kindle (but unfortunately, those devices don't "play" with our e-books.)

Students can "check the e-books out" or "download them" and they have them for 14 days. After 14 days, the book will no longer be accessible to them and will be available for someone else to check out. They can always download it again if they need more time to read it. If it is a picture book, they can choose "read it online" and close the book when they are finished.

Each student was given their own username and password to their account. They will need this to access the catalog called "Follett Shelf." Follett Shelf can be accessed by:

1. Going to the Marston School website
2. Hovering over the "library" tab
3. Clicking on "Follett Shelf"

Note:

1. You will need to disable the "Pop-Up Blocker" on your internet so the download will be able to pop up.
2. The first time you try to download an e-book; you will be prompted to download the software to your device. Follow the instructions, and then download the e-book. Once you have the software, downloading a second book will be easier.
3. There is a help button if you have trouble.
